



Holy man will probe past in SA (South Africa)

A holy man from India, at present a lecture tour of South Africa, will meet African scholars and experts on African culture and folklore in an effort to find positive of an ancient link between the peoples of India and Africa.

Kavi Yogi Maharishi Shuddhananda Bharati, a former university professor turned mystic, told POST this week that there was little doubt that the countinent of Africa was joined with India many thousands of years ago to form the ancient continent of Lemuria.
